

Old Black Horse

17th Century Coaching Inn



St. Clements, Oxford. OX4 1AR

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The Inn is easy to reach whether you are travelling by car or using public transport.

Road

From the South East (London & M40)

Leave the M40 at junction 8, signed Oxford, and follow the A40 to the Headington roundabout.

At the roundabout, take the second exit; signed for Headington and the city (A420 - London Road). This road will become Headington Road and finally St. Clements Street.

The Inn is situated on the corner of St. Clement's Street and Dawson Street. The entrance to the car park is in Dawson Street.

If you miss the Inn, use the roundabout at the end of St. Clement's Street to double-back.

From the South (A34)

Leave the A34 at the junction signed for the Ring Road (Eastern Bypass - A423 / A4142 and M40).

Take the third exit from the roundabout joining the A423, Eastern bypass.

At the third roundabout take the first exit, the Iffley Road, A4158, following signs for the City Centre.

At the roundabout where the Iffley Road, Cowley Road and the High Street meet, take the third exit, St. Clement's Street.

The Inn is situated on the Corner of St. Clement's Street and Dawson Street. The entrance to the car park is in Dawson Street.

From the North and West (M40, A34, A40 etc.)

The centre of Oxford is closed to all through traffic between 7:30am and 6:30pm.

The route into town via the A420, from the west is often congested and motorists are advised to use the ring road to approach the centre via the A4158 - Iffley Road.

Travelling from the North, the easiest route is along the B4150 -

Marston Road (signed to the JR Hospital from the A40 Northern Bypass). Alternatively the Banbury Road offers a viable route outside of peak hours.

Rail

Oxford is on the mainline from London with connecting services to the West and North. For up to date train times ring 08457 484950. The walk from the station to the Inn (approx. 1 mile) takes you through the heart of historic Oxford. Alternatively, it is a pleasant taxi ride. There is a licensed taxi rank immediately outside the station.

Coach

The Airport Express coaches from Heathrow and Gatwick Airports; the Oxford Tube and Oxford Express Coaches from Victoria; all stop on St. Clement's Street, outside the Old Black Horse.
